



Do you have questions about childcare in your Home Team?

Here is a list of ways some of our Home Teams are dealing with the tough issue of childcare.

- **Group members take responsibility for their own child care.**
 - This is probably the most popular way but a group must be sensitive to group members who do not have family close or have just moved here recently.
- **Group hires a sitter and brings kids to group.**
 - This method works well and normally has the adults meet upstairs and the kids are downstairs with the sitter during the group gathering.
- **The child care is rotated between the group members.**
 - The members of a group take turns watching the children while the other group members meet for their study. In some cases the children are taught a small group study.
- **Thursday Night Childcare at the Church for Laugh Your Way**
 - Parents may sign up and drop their kids off at the church and go to their group. For more information use the contact information below to learn how to take advantage of this option.
